Conference Aston boasts an exceptional location, benefitting from extensive transport links; we would like to promote using public transport when visiting our venues. Mainline stations are indicated on the map below and overleaf and all stations are within walking distance.

If you walk from New Street station, the average person will burn approximately 66 calories! That means you can enjoy a biscuit with your coffee when you arrive and not feel guilty!

Taking the train instead of the car means you reduce your carbon emissions by up to two thirds!

Rail travel

New Street, Snow Hill and Moor Street train stations are all within 20 minutes walk of the venue or a 5 minute taxi journey. Please visit www.thetrainline.com to find appropriate routes into Birmingham.

Bus routes

Taxi drop off points

All of the venues have taxi drop off points. Be sure to say to your driver that they should go to either Aston Business School Conference Centre or the Lakeside Centre on the Aston University campus.

Satellite navigation devices

The official postcode for the venues is B4 7ET, however on some systems this will not direct you to the right location; ensure you set your system to Aston Street which is where Aston Business School Conference Centre is located and then use the map overleaf to find the local pay and display car parks.

From M6 North and South

Exit at Junction 6 and follow A38M towards City Centre.

Take lane 2 of the A38M for almost 2 miles and take the 3rd exit off, immediately after the underpass, before the flyover and Aston University will be on your left hand side.

Stay in the left-hand lane alongside the University and at the round-about (with the old Fire Station on the left) take the 1st exit. Follow the map overleaf for local car parks and directions to the appropriate venue.

From M42 East Midlands

From the M42 join the M6 northbound heading towards Birmingham Central. Leave the M6 at junction 6, A38M central and follow the directions from M6 North and South above.

From M5 South-West and City Centre

Leave the M5 at Junction 3 and follow the A456 for about 5 miles towards the City Centre.

As you approach the City, the road broadens to three lanes. Take the outside lane following signs for the ICC and Broad Street. Take the under pass into Broad Street.

Drive all the way along Broad Street and at the roundabout merge right and then stay in the left Lane, take the 2nd exit following the signs for Inner Ring Road, North and M6, Lichfield A38.

Keep in the outside lane and take the underpass (St Chad's Circus Queensway) signed Lichfield A38.

At the end of the underpass, exit left immediately before the flyover.

At the round-about take the 3rd exit off (past the old Fire Station). Follow the map overleaf for local car parks and directions to the appropriate venue.

From M40 Oxford and the South

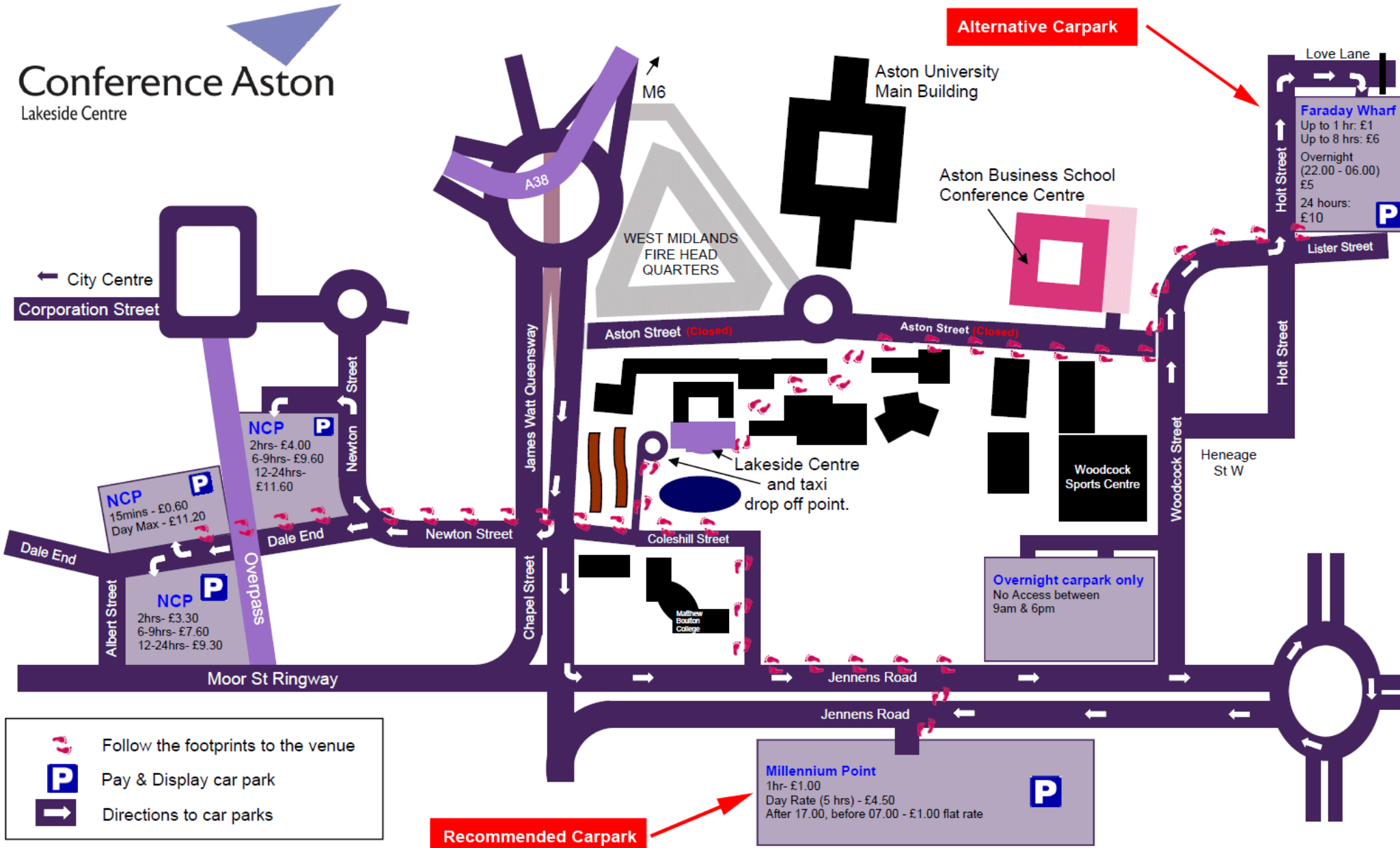
Take M40 northbound and join the M42 westbound towards the M5. Travel north on the M5, leaving at junction 3 and follow directions from M5 South-West above.

Pay and display car parks are close by; please refer to the map overleaf for details of location and charges.

For guests staying overnight within Aston Business School Conference Centre, a luggage drop off point is available at the main entrance. Please proceed to pay and display car parks thereafter as detailed in the map overleaf.
